

Please:-

- 1) pick up after your dog.
- 2) be prompt at turnaround time, especially with the muddy weather - try to aim to have your dog in the car by the end of your session. In Hyde Bark please aim to leave the car park by the end of your appointment time. Some people need to use the car park gates to lock themselves in before letting their dogs out of the car.
- 3) be aware that many people use the field because they have reactive dogs so please keep your dog in the car until the previous users have left.
- 4) try to stop your dog from digging if possible - as you will see there are holes, particularly in Central which we do keep filling but they get dug again almost straight away.
- 5) Report any holes/gaps in the fence asap - burrowing activity and dogs digging mean gaps can be created which smaller dogs can get through.
- 6) You are welcome to use the 4 acres that extends through the gate in Central Bark but this is an enclosed field rather than a secure field. A secure fence is on the list of work to complete next year.
- 7) No smoking in the fields.
